Essay Policy

To receive full credit students:

- must have their essays typed in size 12 or 14 font
- must use Times New Roman or Calibri font
- must use black ink only
- No word art allowed. (unless teacher states differently)
- Students must put their name on the assignment. **5 points** are taken off for missing names.
- Students must hand their essay in on time. Late essays lose **10 points** each day they are late. Work will not be accepted after being 2 days late. After 2 days, students who have not handed in their assignment will receive a zero.

Homework Policy

- Homework is an essential part of the learning experience. It is an extension of the learning process and will help ensure mastery of the skill. Make sure your homework is done to the best of your ability.
- Homework will be graded in the following way:

100% - assignment is handed in on time with all work shown, and student's name is on the paper

50% - assignment is **ONE** day late with all work shown and student's name is on the paper 0%- assignment is 2 or more days late

- Work handed in without all work shown will lose points. ALWAYS SHOW YOUR WORK!
 Even if you don't completely understand a problem, show your thinking. Write your questions and show all attempts.
- Students must put their name on the assignment. 5 points are taken off for missing names.
- Students that do not have their homework on the day it is due must fill out a missing
 homework sheet and have it signed by their parent/guardian and returned to school the
 next day.
